Dear Christelle,

Becromal Iceland ehf started its production only 2 years ago. After an accident with sodium hydroxide (30%) with 2 workers in the last year we looked into safety equipment to make the work with chemicals safer and be able for right counter measurements in case of other eventual accidents.

We have since earlier this year the Diphoterine® mural stations (eye shower and body spray) installed at different locations in our company. Also in the laboratory and with the machine/equipment cleaning personal who have to work with sodium hydroxide on a regular base. Also are all high risk workers equipped with the spray (DAPmicro) for the belt and the individual eye showers. The Diphoterine® spray is often used, when the workers get in skin contact with small splashes of soda, which reduces the skin irritation and the workers are very comfortable using the spray.

As a safety and environment supervisor I feel content as I know that we cannot total eliminate accidents in the future but to know that in the case of a chemical accident our people can be treated immediately against the dangers of hazardous chemicals.
